#### **FOUNDATION MISSION**

City of Smile Charitable Foundation was established in 2014. The founders are a group of hematologists and oncologists. The mission of the Foundation is to stand by children and young adults, through the age of 25, with cancer and blood diseases, and help them and their families in their challenging journey of conquering cancer. On our way to fulfilling the mission of Foundation, we strive to do our best for the continued development of oncology and hematology in Armenia. The Foundation also supports doctors and medical institutions so that they can provide high-quality diagnosis and effective treatment for their patients.

### HOW TO BECOME A BENEFICIARY

All children and young adults, through the age of 25, with cancer or blood diseases, living in Armenia, Artsakh, Javakhk, and receiving treatment in Armenia are eligible to become beneficiary of City of Smile Charitable Foundation.

STEP 1. Upon being diagnosed, the patient or the patient's family visit the Foundation and submit a written application.

STEP 2. The application among with the necessary medical documents are sent to Foundation experts for further approval.

STEP 3. Once the application is approved by the experts, the patient is eligible to become a beneficiary of the Foundation, after which the City of Smile covers the costs related to the his/her treatment in Armenia.

### **ALLOGENEIC BONE MARROW** TRANSPLANTATION IN ARMENIA FOR MALIGNANT DISEASES

In 2023, with the financial support of the City of Smile Foundation, the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Armenia, and the DKMS Center, the first allogeneic bone marrow transplantation procedure was performed at the Yeolyan Hematology and Oncology Center.

The procedure was handled by the Armenian Bone Marrow Transplantation (ArmBMT) team of doctors with continuous advisory support from Dr. Paul-Gerhard Schlegel, a pediatric doctor from the Würzburg University Hospital in Germany.





### ALLOGENEIC BONE MARROW TRANSPLANTATION IN ARMENIA FOR MALIGNANT DISEASES

The implementation of the allogeneic transplantation program in Armenia is unprecedented and creates great opportunities for treating children and adult patients with malignant blood diseases.

At the beginning of 2024, thanks to an initiative by the City of Smile Foundation, children with neuroblastoma no longer need to leave their families and go abroad to receive expensive immunotherapy, as treatment is already available in Armenia.



To ensure that all children receive healthy, vitamin-rich, and balanced meals during their treatment, the Foundation provides a four-meal daily food package to all children during their stay at the hospital.

### PEDIATRIC PALLIATIVE CARE CLINIC 2024



#### 34 chlildren

have received needed care and medical assistance at the Pediatric Palliative Care Clinic of Armenia with the support of the City of Smile Foundation, as of December 31, 2024.

In 2021, with the initiative and funding of the City of Smile Foundation and the advisory support of the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in the USA, the first and only pediatric palliative care clinic in Armenia was opened at the Yeolyan Hematology and Oncology Center.

Since the day of its establishment, the City of Smile Foundation has been providing food, medicine, and medical equipment, as well as psychological support to the patients and their families.



# REHABILITATION CENTER IN TAVUSH 2024






In April, the famous actress and TV host Sati Spivakova became the Goodwill Ambassador of City of Smile Foundation.
